Producer Profiles



Puiatti was founded in 1967 by Vittorio Puiatti in the northeastern corner of Italy's Friuli region. Vittorio was a pioneer of modern winemaking methods and sought to highlight Friuli's indigenous and international grape varieties by emphasizing their purity – no oak is ever used in production. Bordered by Slovenia, Austria and the Adriatic Sea, the Friuli wine region benefits from both maritime and continental climates. The cool, dry Bora wind coming down from the Balkans alternates with breezes blowing in from the Adriatic Sea. Friulano is a grape varietal that thrives in such conditions, and Puiatti's "Vuj" Friulano is a quintessential expression of the elegance and sophistication that Friulano can showcase with some age. Meyer lemon, melon, star fruit and floral aromatics are abundant over a rich palate of Macadamia nut and a hint of dry sherry.
