Primitivo, a.k.a. Zinfandel (or Tribidrag in Croatia from which it originates) is a sun-loving grape that produces lush, medium-bodied fruit forward wines when vinified as is showcased in Tormaresca’s “Torcicoda” from Salento in Puglia. 100% barrel-aged Primitivo, “Torcicoda” is rich with deep fruit, baking spice, dark chocolate and oak flavors over a medium-bodied palate.
