## Producer Profiles: Corte Pavone of Montalcino



Located in Tuscany, Corte Pavone extends for 16 hectares across the scenic Montalcino hillsides at an altitude of 500 meters above sea level. This unique landscape and climate along with the light, clay soils contribute greatly to the wine's character. The estate was established by Rainer Loacker and has belonged to his family since 1996. Rainer was an organic pioneer when he first started out, opting to use more natural treatments instead of pesticides on his vines. Gradually he made the transition to biodynamic farming, even going as far as building a new bio-architectural cellar at the heart of the winery. This Brunello is deep, dark, and sophisticated. Notes of chocolate, roasted meat, dried figs, and even truffle waft out of the glass. On the palate you're greeted by full body, mouthwatering acid, and strong yet integrated tannin. Enjoy a glass with a few richer sfizi and antipasti, or go for a whole bottle to get you through all the way to your tagliatelle Bolognese or grilled prime beef sirloin.
